New Requirements from the Illinois Department of Health regarding Religious Exemptions

Parents who are requesting a religious exemption to immunizations or examinations **MUST** submit the ILLINOIS CERTIFICATE OF RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION TO REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS AND/OR EXAMINATIONS FORM. The form must be signed by the child's parents **AND** the child's health care provider responsible for performing the child's health examination. A separate form must be used for each child. This form may NOT be used for personal or philosophical reasons. Illinois law does not allow for such exemptions.

New Students

All new students entering K-8 are required to provide a Child Health Exam, Dental Exam, and Vision Exam from Illinois healthcare providers within thirty days of the first day of attendance at Everest Academy. All forms must be dated within one year of the first day of attendance.
