### **New Requirements from the Illinois Department of Health regarding Religious Exemptions**

Parents who are requesting a religious exemption to immunizations or examinations **MUST** submit the ILLINOIS CERTIFICATE OF RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION TO REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS AND/OR EXAMINATIONS FORM. The form must be signed by the child's parents **AND** the child's health care provider responsible for performing the child's health examination. A separate form must be used for each child. This form may NOT be used for personal or philosophical reasons. Illinois law does not allow for such exemptions.

### **New/Transfer Students, entering Grades 1-8 for the first time in an Illinois school.**

Parents are to present proof, before October 15 of the school year, of having been examined by a qualified physician or licensed optometrist within the previous year by submitting the Child Health Exam and Vision Exam from an Illinois healthcare provider within 30 days of first day of attendance to Everest. All forms must be dated within one year of the first day of attendance.
